

Held MAY 16 20 17

Council met in regular session at 7:00 P.M. in council chambers at city hall, 28 W. Friend Street, Columbiana, Ohio 44408 with Mayor Bryan Blakeman presiding. Clerk of Council Deann L. Davis gave the invocation. Blakeman led the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

Also answering roll call were City Manager Lance Willard and Municipal Attorney Daniel A. Blasdell. Council member Dan Bekar was absent.

Each member of council had a copy of the agenda for this regular council meeting.

Each member of council had a copy of the minutes of the regular council meeting held on May 2, 2017. The minutes stand as presented.

Blakeman read a proclamation for National Police Officer's Week. Police Chief Tim Gladis introduced the police officers who were present. Gladis and the officers were recognized for their service with a standing ovation.

Blakeman read a proclamation for Alexis Janelle Krosky Day.

Each council member had a copy of the Columbiana Planning Commission meeting minutes of May 9, 2017; and the Columbiana Park, Recreation, and Cemetery Board meeting minutes of April 24, 2017.

Willard presented council members with the mayor's court and EMS department reports for April 2017. Willard presented council members with bid results for asphalt, gas/diesel fuel, and lime for the water treatment plant.

Willard presented council members with the manager's update.

Council members reviewed the bill list of May 16, 2017.

There was no old business.

Blakeman noted under new business there were four ordinances and three resolutions. Blakeman noted Ordinances 17-O-2920 and 2923 were emergency ordinances. Liston moved that, due to the length of the ordinances, and because each member of council had a copy in his or her possession, Blakeman read the ordinances and resolutions by title only and to suspend the rule requiring an ordinance or resolution be read at two separate meeting dates of council for the purpose of an emergency. McBane moved to reset the previously scheduled public hearing on June 6, 2017, at 7:15 P.M. regarding amendment to Section 1260.16 to June 13, 2017, at 6:45 P.M., which will be the recessed meeting of June 6, 2017.
