Souder moved to approve Ordinance 17-O-2917 under the suspension of rules as an emergency. Liston seconded the motion and on roll call: Souder, yea; McBane, yea; Liston, yea; Noel, yea; and Bekar, yea. (Motion Passed.)

Blakeman read Ordinance 17-O-2918 by title only-----
"AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 17-O-2900 BY ADDING FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS IN THE FIRE ESCROW FUND ALL FOR THE PAYMENT OF CURRENT EXPENSES AS THEY MAY ARISE."

Souder moved to approve Ordinance 17-O-2918 under the suspension of rules as an emergency. Noel seconded the motion and on roll call: McBane, yea; Liston, yea; Noel, yea; Bekar, yea; and Souder, yea. (Motion Passed.)

Blakeman read Ordinance 17-O-2919 in its entirety-----
"AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1260.16 OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING CODE OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF COLUMBIANA, OHIO."

Noel moved to approve Ordinance 17-O-2919 under FIRST READING. Souder seconded the motion. Discussion followed on only allowing gardens in rear yards.

McBane moved to amend the ordinance to remove the words, "within the confines of a rear yard." Souder seconded the motion.

On roll call for the amendment: Liston, yea; Noel, yea; Bekar, yea; Souder, yea; and McBane, yea. (Motion Passed.)

Planning Commission member Tucker Cope, Jr. appeared before council and stated he feels gardens should only be allowed in rear yards.

Ethan Surgenavic appeared before council and suggested the city establish a setback for gardens.

On roll call for the ordinance as amended: Noel, yea; Bekar, yea; Souder, yea; McBane, yea; and Liston, yea. (Motion Passed.)

Blakeman read Resolution 17-R-505 in its entirety-----
"A RESOLUTION AMENDING SECTIONS 1260.35 (DEFINITION OF 'AGRICULTURE'), 1270.02(a), 1272.02(a) AND 1274.02(a) OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING CODE OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF COLUMBIANA, OHIO, AS WELL AS SECTION 618.01(b) AND (d) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF COLUMBIANA, OHIO."

McBane moved to approve Resolution 17-R-505 under FIRST READING. Liston seconded the motion.

Discussion followed on the number of chickens. Noel distributed a list of pros and cons to council members and the audience.

Mallory Cooper, Tony Dolan, Don and Mary Ann Kelly appeared before council to speak in favor of allowing chickens.

Chuck Martin and Becky McMurray appeared before council to speak in opposition of allowing chickens.

On roll call: Bekar, nay; Souder, yea; McBane, yea; Liston, yea; and Noel, nay. (Motion Failed First Reading.)

McBane moved to adjourn this regular meeting at 8:45 P.M. and all members of council concurred.
